

Entrance, Front Lobby, and Office

Enter the hotel through two sets of automatic sliding doors. Check in is straight ahead. Water coolers, pet play space, and bathrooms are to the right. The IMsLBB office is to the left. Knock before entering.

The entrance to the hotel has two sets of automatic slide doors with a vestibule in between.

Upon entering the hotel lobby there's a set of tables lined up for check-in straight ahead.

To the immediate left is the entrance to the office for IMsLBB staff. Knock before entering, supplies are usually scattered around as the staff handles all events, classes, and happenings throughout the hotel.

To the right of the lobby entrance is a hallway with tiled flooring. On the left are two water coolers on a table with cups. In front of the table is a garbage can. Down the hallway just past the water coolers on the left is a pet play space with various toys and a mat.

Bathroom Area

There are two non-gendered bathrooms with ADA stalls. One bathroom has urinals and stalls, the other just stalls.

Turn right after entering the lobby and walk about 10 paces down the hallway. Past the coolers and play space, bathrooms are on the left wall. There are two non-gendered bathrooms, the first has urinals and stalls, the second has just stalls. The first bathroom has an ADA Accessible stall to the right of the entrance. The second bathroom has an ADA Accessible stall straight ahead.

At the end of the hallway is a large room with racks of goods and clothing where IMsLBB staff manage items from the silent auction.

Doorway: 36"

Main Lobby

The main lobby is a large space with couches straight ahead. Layout scanning left to right: double door dungeon entrance; step and repeat; carpeted hallway to elevator and classrooms, bootblack drop off tables and bootblack stations against the courtyard windows; courtyard entrance, tables for food serving, hallway to the kitchen, tables to sit, a hallway to the ballroom.

The main lobby is a large open space. Left of the hotel reception desk are snacks and beverages to be purchased at reception.

Across from the reception desk are two long grey couches.

To the right of the couches is one of the dungeon entrances, it has propped open double doors. To the right of that is a step and repeat that reads "IMsLBB5"

Past the reception desk and snacks looking straight into the main lobby/lounge area, it opens to a large space. This area has four couches and around five tables. Each table has 4-8 chairs.

Continuing ahead, on the back-wall of the lobby is the bootblack table and a row of bootblack stations against a row of windows.

Entering the main lobby/lounge, make a left and the dungeon is straight ahead. The dungeon is a dimly lit room with double doors at one entrance and a single door at the other.

At bootblack drop off the two tables extend to the right in front of a row of windows. Further right are 3 bootblack stations, on the continued windows.

Elevator and Classrooms

The classrooms are on the left side of the hotel lobby, past the pay space, to the left of the bootblack station. The classrooms fit about 30 people, the elevator fits 5 people (snug). This first elevator is kept Latex free.

Through open double doors the first classroom is on the immediate right, the door swings inward to a walkway to the front of the classroom, with rows of chairs on the left. There is harsh fluorescent lighting.

The elevator is on the left after the open double doors. Down the hallways are hotel rooms.

Doorway: 36"

The Courtyard

The courtyard entrance is a swinging glass door along a wall of windows. There is a lip to get onto and off of the court yard.

The ground is tiled concrete, easy to roll over. A stone path continues into the gazebo straight ahead. Grass is on either side of this path. Through the gazebo, the path continues to the left and right. There is an additional door from the courtyard into the restaurant and ballroom area. If you are facing the building from the courtyard, it is to the far left and opens inward.

Courtyard sidewalks: 47 ½" & 77"wide
